



How it works

- Every hand on the card has a value printed beside it, usually 25 to 50. Harder hands are worth more.
- Groups that play for money usually count the value in cents: a 25 hand is 25¢. Many groups keep score on paper instead.
- There is no bonus for the dealer. East pays and collects like everyone else.

Who pays what

How the hand was won	The player who threw it	Each other player
Called a discard for Mahjong	2× the value	1× the value
Drew the winning tile from the wall (self-drawn)	No discarder	2× the value (all three)
Jokerless, on a discard	4× the value	2× the value
Jokerless, self-drawn	No discarder	4× the value (all three)

Example: a 25 hand

Situation	Payments	Total
On a discard	Thrower 50, others 25 each	100
Self-drawn	Everyone 50	150
Jokerless, on a discard	Thrower 100, others 50 each	200
Jokerless, self-drawn	Everyone 100	300

Jokerless fine print

- No Jokers anywhere in the winning hand, concealed or exposed.
- **Announce it.** Say “Jokerless” when you declare. The League has ruled that the bonus isn’t owed if you don’t.
- Singles and Pairs hands never get the bonus. They can’t use Jokers, and the card value already reflects it.
- Quint hands don’t get the bonus either.

When things go wrong

- **Wall game:** no winner, nobody pays.
- **Dead hand:** stops playing, still pays the winner.
- **Dead-hand challenge:** if the challenged player denies it, check the hand at the end. Whoever was wrong pays the other 50.
- **False Mahjong:** the caller’s hand is dead. Check every win against the card before anyone pays or mixes tiles.

Table rules (not official)

- **Pie:** each player brings a fixed amount; once it’s gone, they play on at no further risk.
- **Kitty:** a pot paid into after wall games, collected by the next winner.
- **Hot wall / cold wall / pay for the party:** extra penalties late in a hand. Officially, the thrower only ever pays double.
- Agree any of these before the first hand.
